



## School Uniform

All students in Year 7 to 11 are required to wear school uniform. Details of the uniform are shown below; the majority of the items are widely available in high street shops and other retail outlets. Monetary assistance may be available for children in receipt of free school meals. Further details are available from the school.

## General

- All students are expected to wear school uniform and maintain a clean and tidy appearance.
- All students are required to have the correct equipment and kit in school for PE lessons.
- The wearing of make-up is not encouraged. Minimal make-up with a skin tone foundation is acceptable, but students will be asked to remove excessive make-up if worn.
- It is not acceptable for students to adapt their general appearance to follow certain fashions of the day.

## Hair

- Extremes of style and colour are not acceptable.
- Tramlines/designs are not acceptable in hairstyles.

## Jewellery

Students are responsible for the security of their own jewellery.  
The only items of jewellery allowed are:

- a small, plain single stud in each ear (to be removed for games)
- a plain, simple ring (to be removed for games, and design and technology lessons)
- a watch

Please note, facial piercings are not permitted and individuals will be told to remove them.

## Uniform

**Girls' Uniform Compulsory** – The girl's skirt and trousers are available from Hawkinsport and Sportcrest. The uniform is to be worn by all girls in Years 7 -11.

- **Skirt** only the specified **black** skirt may be worn.
- **Trousers** must be plain **black**, wide leg style, without lycra and not fitted.
- **Shirt** must be plain **white**. (Shirts should be tucked in at all times; top buttons should be done up; and any garment worn under them should not be visible.)
- **Tie** must have the **school crest** on it. The school crest should be visible on the tie at all times. (It should be purchased in house colours.)
- **Jumper** must be a plain, long sleeved and **V-necked**. This garment is optional. Cardigans, sweatshirts and hooded tops are not allowed.
- **Socks** must be plain in colour.
- **Tights** should be natural or black in colour.
- **Shoes** must be a plain, black leather type, with low solid heels. (Trainers, plimsolls, canvas, stiletto heels, open sandals or backless shoes are not suitable for school.)
- **Blazer** must be **black** with the **school badge** on the breast pocket.
- **Belt** must be black, simple and plain in style.
- **Coats** are allowed during the winter; students should have a suitable winter coat to wear.
- **Hats** for warmth in the winter or for sun protection in summer are permitted, but they must not be worn indoors.

## Personal Belongings

### Mobile Phones

- The school does not accept any responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged phones.
- Phones must be turned off during the day. This includes break and lunchtime.
- Any phone seen or heard in school will be confiscated and a parent or carer will be required to come and collect it from the Headteacher the following day.
- Mobile phones are not to be used in lessons or between lessons unless clearly authorised by the teacher responsible for the class. Any breach of this rule will result in the phone being confiscated and safely stored in the main reception. On the first occasion the student will have the opportunity to discuss the matter with the Headteacher/Deputy Headteacher and potentially retrieve it at the end of the day. On subsequent occasion the phone will need to be collected by a parent/carer at a meeting. A record will be kept by the front office so confiscation of mobile phones can be monitored.

### I-pods and MP3 Players

- The school does not accept any responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged i-pods or MP3 players.
- If used during the school day they will be confiscated.
