GOOD TO EXCELLENT BREAKFAST CLUB

Dear Parent /Carer

I wish to start a breakfast club for boys. I have run these previously and we have had great success with many positive comments from pupils, teachers and parents. One of the reasons I decided on a breakfast club is because I do not want to take them out of lessons to monitor them.

The time I spend with them, is to offer praise, motivation and advice. To that end, I have decided to utilise the time available before school to run a 'Good to Excellent Breakfast Club' again.

It has been arranged that the club will take place on a Thursday morning once a month, starting on Thursday 23rd November 2017. It will run for 6 months.

Great Marlow School will provide the breakfast (Bacon or Egg roll and a Hot Chocolate) and begin serving at 7-30am, so that the meeting can officially start at 7-45am, with an approximate end time of 8.15am. This is enough time to give all the pupils involved a chance to meet in a social setting, where they can offer mutual support and motivation to each other. The price of the breakfast for the six months is £9.

It will enable me, as their Director of Learning, to spend some quality time with them. At this meeting, I intend to: discuss strategies to help the pupils move forward; discuss problems or barriers to learning that may have arisen; and set achievable challenges for the month ahead. It is important that all pupils recognise this as a formal meeting, with a serious focus, that will demand their concentration and participation.

There is a six-month commitment from all parties. There are limited places so It is important your son wishes to participate in and will join in fully.

You will get after every meeting: Notes on what we have covered, a motivational quote (which MUST be printed and stuck where your son does his homework). They will be expected to sit down with you and discuss their targets at least once in the month.

I am hoping that your child will be better prepared for Key Stage 4 and will be able to become determined to do well in their learning.
