The Design & Technology department are very pleased and excited to be welcoming your child onto the creative KS4 journey that they have opted for.

Over the course of the next two academic years, each GCSE Design and Technology student (Graphics, Textiles, Resistant Materials) will be completing design and make projects for products and packaging as part of their skills development, and their NEA work (Non-Exam Assessment).

Students are already beginning to experiment with higher level skills, processes, and techniques to further their expertise and increase their NEA marks. We are expecting great results from the enthusiasm and motivation that we have seen from the students thus far.
