Dear Parents and Carers of Year 9,

I am writing to give an overview of your child(ren)'s transition into Year 10.

## Teaching and Learning:

As you know, up until now, students in the cohort have been taught each of their lessons within their teaching band of Chiltern, Marlow and Thames.

You will also be aware that each Year 10 student has secured 4 optional GCSE Subjects. With these changes to their timetable, students will find themselves in classes with students from outside of the band they have been in for their KS3 years.

The core subjects of English, Maths, Science and Physical Education will continue to be studied by all students in the Year Group; these will be taught in ability based classes within their house (Eagles, Hawks or Kites).

Students will receive their printed timetables on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September when they join Year 10; These timetables are usually available on the Xpressions app a few days earlier.

## Pastoral Support:

I will continue to be your child(ren)'s Director of Learning into Year 10 and Mrs Connor-Price will continue to be their Student Support Officer.

Our office base will change to the KS4 Student Support Office (located by G Block on site). Should your child(ren) be unaware of where this, I would encourage them to seek it out in the first few days of school.
