Bands...

- Greater flexibility in Maths, English and Science, in terms of setting
- In **non core subjects**, opportunity for more equal class sizes “teacher time” but also flexibility in class sizes
- Improved continuity of classes through KS3
- GCSE non core subjects are completely mixed ability classes
