



Great Marlow School Prefect Code of Conduct

As a school prefect, there is an additional responsibility on your shoulders to lead by example and be an ambassador for both the year group and the school. The role of the prefect is an important one at Great Marlow School: one that has a long history. There is an expectation that prefects will take on extra responsibilities and be available to support in wider school events.

- Be dressed appropriately in accordance with the uniform policy at all times.
- Maintain an excellent attendance record.
- Be punctual to school and lessons.
- Show a good to outstanding attitude towards learning.
- Be respectful to all teachers, peers and the school environment.
- Be willing to take on additional responsibility.
- Demonstrate resilience.
- Maintain a positive and enthusiastic outlook.
- Show a readiness to learn.
- Demonstrate resourcefulness.

Failure to maintain these high standards could result in the loss of prefect status.
