#### What's Included in your Silver Expedition.

#### Training.

The training will consist of two days of training, including sleeping in tents. During the two days we will work with you on the basic skills required for your journey to successfully completing your Silver Level Qualifying Expedition.

During these first two days you will work as a team with our qualified and very experienced Instructors to learn and continue to develop your core skills in:

Navigation / Route Planning
First Aid and Emergency Procedures
Camp Craft – Tents and Tarp Shelter as well as Expedition Cooking and Nutrition
Teamwork – Team Dynamics, Expectations of each other, Roles.
Country Code / Leave no trace
Health and Safety
Kit Expectations and Ideas (Aimed at enhancing the Canoeing experience)





#### What's Included in your Silver Expedition.

#### **Practice Expedition.**

The Silver Level Practice Expedition is the next step on the learning ladder. Following the two days training you will complete a further two days in expedition mode, enabling you to put your skills and growing experiences into practice, with the support of the instructing team. The two days will be a mixture of direct and remote supervised activities.

The two days will consist of planning a route, including overnight camp, travelling along this route over the two days (initially with direct support from an instructor). If any further skills are needed we will support you with this but as your confidence grows and you feel more comfortable working as part of your team, the supervision level will be reduced, until you can work on your own.

Fri 1st July 2022 – Day 1 of Qualifying Expedition - Paddle from Glasbury to Whitney

Sat 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 – Day 2 of Qualifying Expedition - Paddle from Whitney to Preston

Sun 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2022 – Day 3 of Qualifying Expedition - Paddle from Preston to Hereford

Sun 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2022– Return to School.









#### What's Included in your Silver Expedition.

#### **Qualifying Expedition.**

The Qualifying Expedition is where you put all your skills and experiences together and complete a three day expedition (including two overnight camps) with remote supervision from the instructing team.

Although being assessed can be a daunting experience for some and the expectations at Silver are much higher, the instructing team will make sure that you are supported if needed. The expedition is aimed at enabling you to show us you have learnt and have gain sufficient knowledge to successfully complete your expedition, have worked as a team and hopefully had fun along the way.
