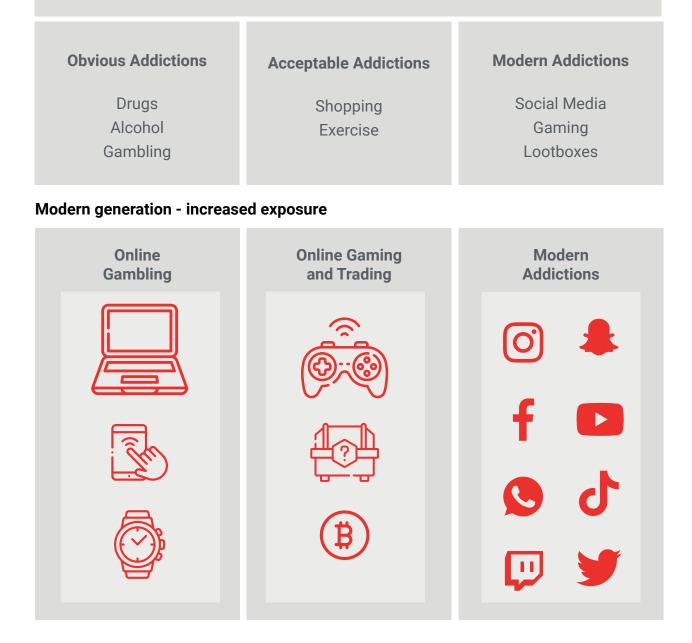

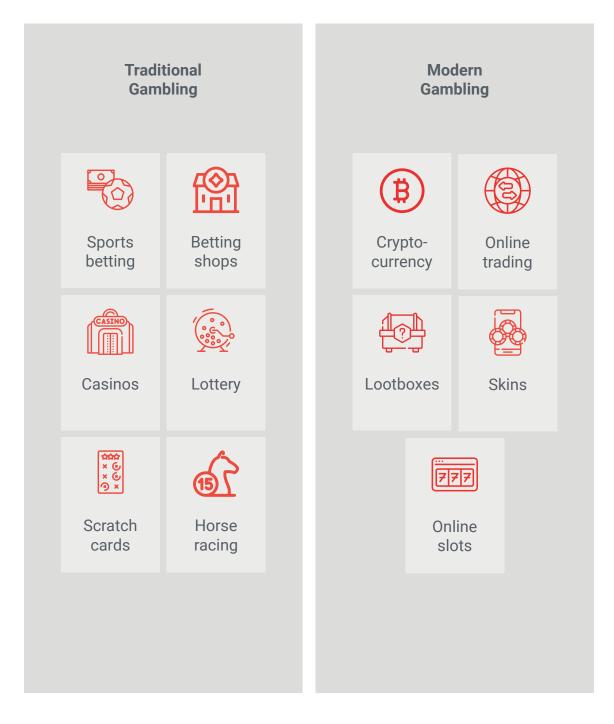
What is addiction?

- Avoiding friends or social activities

- Suicidal thoughts
