## The Audition Process

- 1) Choose one of the audition scripts and practice how you feel the character would say the lines. (It is not essential for you to learn the audition piece, but it does help with your acting performance.)
- 2) Decide upon the type of part you would like. If it is a major to a medium role you should attend auditions on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September in E10 at 3.15pm. If you are just interested in becoming involved, you should attend the auditions on Thursday 8th September in E10 at 3:15pm.
- 3) There might be some call backs on Thursday so try and keep both days free.
- 4) It is not possible to give exact times for the character auditions. Students will phone parents and carers when they have completed their auditions.
- 5) No decisions will be made on audition days. The cast decision makers will finalise the cast list by Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> September. It will be published in E10.
- 6) Following the publication of the cast, a schedule will issued so students can check these dates and make sure they are workable for families.
- 7) Those accepting a main part, comes with the expectation that the student will be committed to attending all rehearsals for the show.
- 8) On Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September (from 3:15 pm until 3:45pm) there is a meeting to sort out the administration; it is at this meeting the student commits to the show.
