Diploma in Foundation studies taster session visit to Bucks New University, High Wycombe

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the A level Art and Design course for Year 13, The Art & Design Department have been offered the unique opportunity to attend and take part in an Art and Design Foundation course taster session workshop hosted by Bucks New University in High Wycombe.

The University visit will give students the vital experience of working in a higher education environment, and will offer an invaluable opportunity to explore and learn about a range of media, techniques and processes. The visit to BNU is designed to further enhance our student's cultural and contextual understanding of specific specialisms, and will involve producing practical outcomes which will contribute to their A Level portfolio and current projects in progress.

The trip will take place on **Wednesday 7th December 2022**.

Cost

All workshops are free of charge.

Meals & equipment

Students will need to bring their sketchbooks, drawing equipment and a suitable camera or good camera phone. It is essential that all photographs from the day are downloaded and stored in a safe location as these will be needed at a later date.

Students may wear their own suitable clothing for the trip but should bear in mind that they will be in an educational environment and representing the school.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them.

Travel arrangements

Students will be advised to make their own way to the university campus in High Wycombe and should register directly with Art Staff outside the main entrance at **9.40am** for a prompt 10.00am start. Workshops will run from **10.00am** and the day is expected to finish at **1.00pm**. Students will not be expected to attend their afternoon lessons back at school, but will need to arrange a method of transport home from High Wycombe once the workshop is over.
