Dear Parent/Carer

I would like to take the Eco Warriors on a community project to support the Marlow Wombles with litter picking in Marlow high street.

The visit will include working with the local charity to clean up the high street areas of Marlow reducing litter and therefore actively reducing the impact of climate change. The students have worked hard within the school to keep areas free of litter, and we would love to expand this into the community. Students will be walking between Great Marlow School and Marlow High Street for this activity.

The visit will take place on Monday the 19th of December leaving GMS at 10am returning at 1pm. The students will need to ask their subject teachers for permission to leave during their lessons and take responsibility by catching up on any missed work. The trip is organised and led by Miss Addy.

There is no cost involved in this trip, however, if the students would like to bring some of their own money to purchase a drink they may do. Marlow Wombles have kindly offered us hot drinks and mince pies at the end of the litter picking session as a thank you to the students.

Students will be expected to attend the trip in full school uniform; however, they may wear something 'Christmassy' for the event. They will need to be always on their best behaviour and show responsibility when taking part in this trip. Students will remain in a group with Miss Addy for the duration of the trip and will be encouraged to stay in pairs. The trip aims to be inclusive of all students, regardless of any special educational, medical, or other need.

A consent form will need to be filled out on WisePay before your child will be able to take part in this visit. Please can this be completed by Wednesday the 7th of December.

We are very grateful to the students that take such an active role in the development of our Eco-School status and their continued efforts in making the world a better place. I hope you will also take this opportunity to thank your child for their resilience in this project.
