For the Year groups in school, the classes where their teachers are in school, they will have their lessons as normal. Where their teacher is absent due to strike action, they will be supervised to do independent work in one of our larger communal spaces.

When a Year group is working at home, they will be set work on MS Teams by non-striking teachers to be completed independently by the students during the day. Work will not be set for a class when their teacher is taking industrial action.

Vulnerable Students

We are planning to try and accommodate vulnerable students in school on each of the two days, in addition to the Year groups in school. Vulnerable students are identified as students with an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) or a Child in Need Plan or a Child Protection Plan.
