Dear Parent/ Carer

As the 1st half term draws to a close, I would like to thank you for your continued support at home. We have been incredibly impressed with the levels of *readiness, resilience, respect and resourcefulness* demonstrated by the Y7 cohort during their first half term.

I wanted to take the opportunity to share some key reminders with you to ensure that this continues as we look forward to the second Autumn half term (WB: Monday 30th October).

Planner Signing:

A key part of a successful home-school partnership is the weekly planner signing checks, that take place on a Wednesday morning during tutor time.

Please continue to support us by signing and dating your child's planner on the notes section of each week, ready for their form tutor to sign and check. We recommend that reading and checking your child's planner, along with a conversation about homework and their learning in school, is part of your weekly routine at home at the weekend.

Equipment and Readiness Checks:

In addition to planner signing, readiness and equipment checks take place on a Wednesday morning during form time.

Please can you check over your child's equipment over the half term break and replace any missing equipment. A reminder of our expectations of the equipment list which student need to bring with them to school for each day are below:

- Pencil case
- At least x 2 black or blue pens
- HB pencil
- Green pen
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Colouring pencils
- Highlighter
- Maths set- including calculator, compass and protractor.

Uniform:

As we approach the colder weather, a reminder that the blazer is a compulsory part of your son or daughter's uniform. Plain black "V" neck jumpers are optional, although strongly advised in the cold weather and do not substitute the GMS blazer. In addition, coats are to be worn on top of their blazer.

The only items of jewellery acceptable are: a small plain single stud in each ear, a plain simple ring (both to be removed for PE) or a watch (to be removed for PE and DT lessons). Students are responsible for the security of their own jewellery.
