

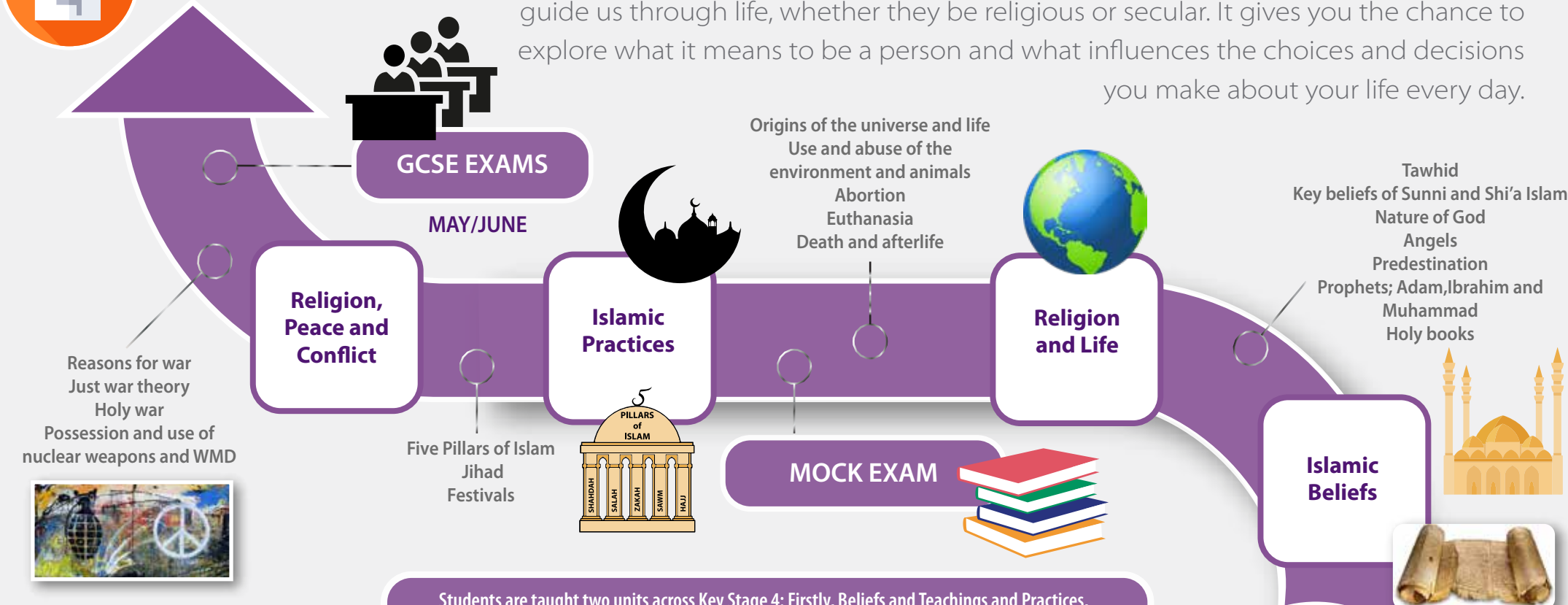


RELIGIOUS EDUCATION LEARNING LADDER

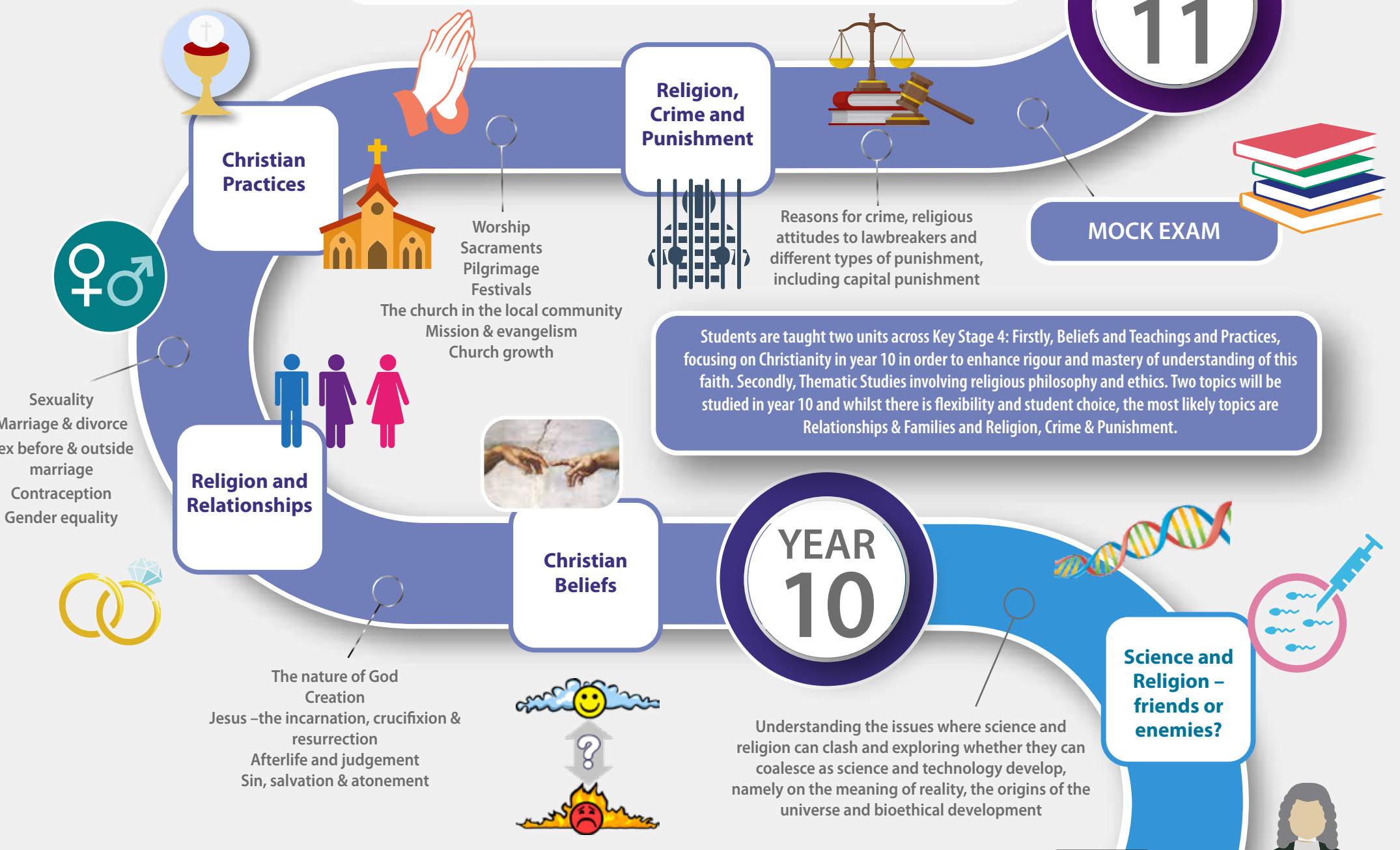


"Understanding and exploring questions of human experience".

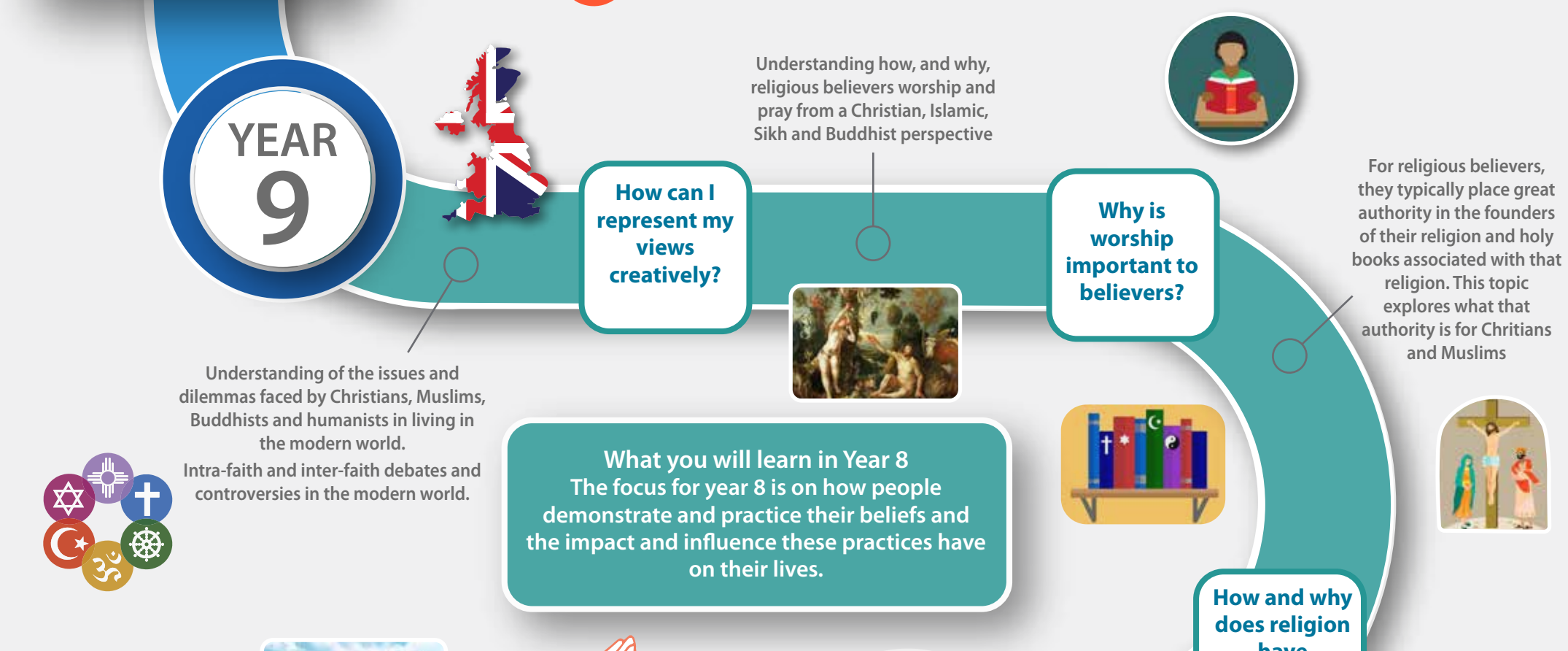


Students are taught two units across Key Stage 4: Firstly, Beliefs and Teachings and Practices, focusing on Islam in year 11 in order to enhance rigour and mastery of understanding of this faith. Secondly, Thematic Studies involving religious philosophy and ethics. Two topics will be studied in year 10 and whilst there is flexibility and student choice, the most likely topics are Relationships & Life and Religion, Peace and Conflict



Students are taught two units across Key Stage 4: Firstly, Beliefs and Teachings and Practices, focusing on Christianity in year 10 in order to enhance rigour and mastery of understanding of this faith. Secondly, Thematic Studies involving religious philosophy and ethics. Two topics will be studied in year 10 and whilst there is flexibility and student choice, the most likely topics are Relationships & Families and Religion, Crime & Punishment.
